



**“Focus on Vocal Variety” speech worksheet\***

**The goal of the Focus on Vocal Variety speech is to use changes in your voice (volume, pitch, speed, and pauses) to get your audience paying attention! Tell us about a time that was really exciting! Was it a special trip? A visit to an amusement park? Seeing your grandparents after a long time? Share the experience with the group and let us hear your excitement!**

Don't forget to use your **gestures** in this speech, (and every speech in the future).

What exciting time will you tell the audience about, and how did you find out you were going to have this experience?

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Tell the audience what happened.

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What were some of the feelings you had during this exciting time?

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How did this (or might this) exciting time change you?

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What exciting experience(s) would you like to have in the future? Why?

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Closing comment(s).

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\* The “Rule of 3”: Complete your speech worksheets at least 3 days before your speech, and practice your presentation out loud, with a timer, until you can meet your time goal 3 times in a row (and you like how your speech is sounding).
