	<div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;"> <div data-bbox="613 758 1177 1249" style="width: 60%;"> <p> <i>“The role of the Timekeeper is to provide speakers with signals for how long they have spoken. For example, I will describe the timing for Impromptus. When you have reached 1 minute, I will raise the green signal; at 1½ minutes, the yellow signal; and at 2 minutes, the red signal. If you do not make it to the red signal (2 minutes), or if you hear the bell, which I will ring at 2½ minutes, you will not be eligible to win for this segment of the meeting. Speeches and evaluations must reach the green signal, but not the bell, to be eligible to receive votes.”</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">TIMEKEEPER INSTRUCTIONS</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> For speeches, listen for the MC’s introduction to hear what speech is being given and/or its timing. If you are not sure, be sure to ask. Wait for the speaker to clearly begin before starting the stopwatch. When it is time to raise a signal, hold it still, easily visible on screen, and keep it held up until it is time to change signals. Do not try to warn speakers if they are getting close to the bell. If you have a problem with the stopwatch, don’t ask the speaker to stop, or make a commotion. Count in your head, using your best judgment to present accurate signaling, then tell the Chairperson before the next person’s turn to be timed. When it is your turn to speak, remind the Impromptu Master to keep time for you. <p>* ELIGIBILITY POINT.
